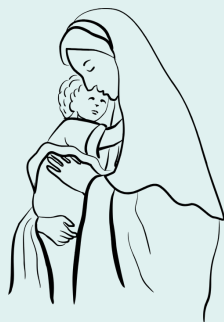
Despite the surprise and the uncertainty about how this could be, you said yes.
