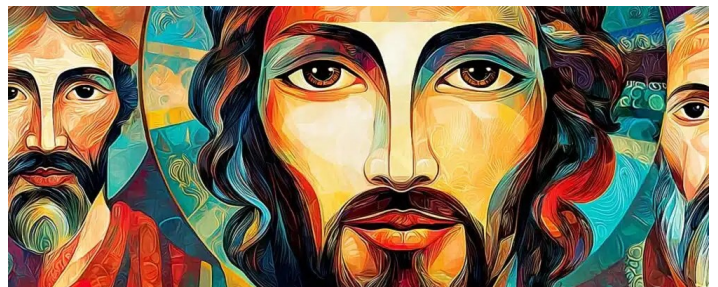

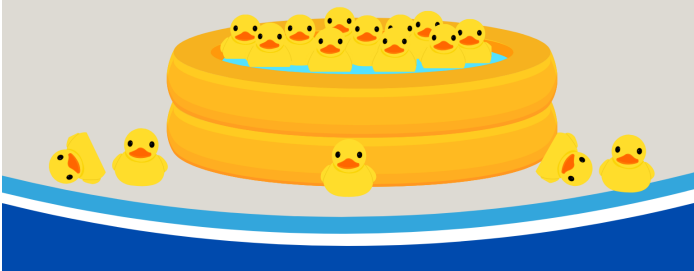
Annual Duck Race Tickets Available for Sale
